#### SCOPE OF SUPPLY AND SERVICES

The scope of supply shall include supply of the new drive unit, operating and maintenance instructions, test certificates and programming and trial test at site of AC variable frequency drives for the motor ratings indicated.

The VFD shall be operated in two modes namely 'DCS' and 'Local'. In DCS mode, starting of drive shall be from DCS via digital input and speed reference is given by 4-20mA signal from DCS. In Local mode, drive shall be started and stopped from panel using push bottom, speed is varied by two push-button (one speed up push-button another speed down push-button).

Speed and current feedback shall be given as analog output 4-20mA to DCS. Necessary isolation for the analog input and output are to be provided by the bidder if required. Three potential free relay output for RUN, TRIP and READY are to be available in the drive module.

The VF drive shall be suitable for installation at a maximum distance of 200 m from the motor
